Call for 2019 Proposals

Not all Steering Committee rankings are in yet.

No scheduled questioning, but can reach out with project/proposal inquires

Branden will distribute questions and answers to proposers/steering committee

Preliminary rankings into Branden by 11/7

USFWS timeline for submission is undetermined

Next scheduled meeting (Dec 3) will be final ranking/selection

Most proposals are straightforward, with a couple more complicated in scope

Start/End dates and deliverables are missing on a few

Many address the strategic plan but not the CAP

Low amount of propsals this year? NO, typical amount of 5-8 propsals

Low amount of applicants? NO, heavy with KWF, which is not unusual

Cooey informed group earlier she was not submitting

RFP has gone out the same time every year

Challenge for on the ground projects

Funds not available for approximately a year after proposal submitted

Favors types of projects with "looser" timeline

Projects need to have other funding knowing USFWS funds will be late

SouthWest HP only had 3 proposal submissions

Steering Committee could develop proposal to submit

Score/Ranking card was created years ago by Steering Committee

Science/Tech Committee ready to roll for next year – too tight timing this year

MatSu proposals were due Oct 22 – should KPFHP move deadline of Oct 5?
