Main Conclusion – benefit from increased coordination and information sharing Left unresolved – goal is unclear

Second Conclusion – biocomplexity project proposed by Ken Tarbox/Bruce King GIS based model of watershed in most sustainable way possible

3-5 page draft being written

Megan Murphy/Heidi Chay will call next meeting after draft ready (6-8 weeks) No need to form other new organization

Ken apologized for giving impression KPFHP wasn't viable

Can KPFHP address coordination needs?

Partnerships encouraged to support/endorse local projects without funding Can claim as a KPFHP project

Need to be cautious about claiming credit for projects supporting

Does the Salmon Symposium get NFHP funding? Yes, past years through MatSu Partnership Should we consider implementing similar here? Presentation of broad range of projects in the MatSu Presentations beyone MatSu funded projects Good forum for discussion Cecil checked proposal for this year's Symposium = \$26,000 (And same match) Cecil will email FY11 proposal

ARRI Project – KWF has no conflict

CIK Project – Should Sue stay on conference call? Can listen, but no voting, may have valuable input Call to question: Can Sue rank competing proposal? 4 NO – 3 YES YES: Jeff, Ricky, Doug NO: Marie, Ginny, Peter, Brent ARRI scoring refigured without Sue's scores = 78

Approximately \$90,000 available – don't have to fund proposals

CIK PROPOSAL DISCUSSION:

Require more details later to flesh out project or fund as presented? Challenging to have proposal changed by committee without funding adjusted Is this in on-going project? Yes – year 5 of 5 Partnership approves project – USFWS is the funding agent

Few details to deal with on objectives

Agreement to fund project as presented for details to work out with USFWS If significant changes financially, can bring back to partnership

MAJORITY APPROVAL TO FUND PROPOSAL AND MOVE FORWARD TO USFWS

ARRI PROPOSAL DISCUSSION:

Need months of sampling to obtain objectives

August only seems too short of period

Should have more robust effort over whole summer

Can we approach to flesh out project – resubmit with larger sampling effort? Budget weak and match already stretched

If larger funding – match is unlikely

50% match is regional requirement – match from other projects? Other similar projects may have contributing data

MAJORITY AGREEMENT TO DECLINE TO FUND PROPOSAL AS SUBMITTED *MAJORITY AGREEMENT NOT TO ASK FOR RESUBMITTAL*

\$65,000 leftover funding available
